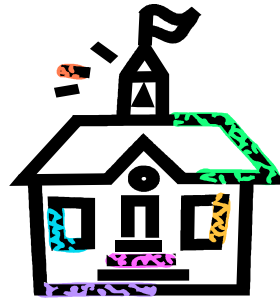

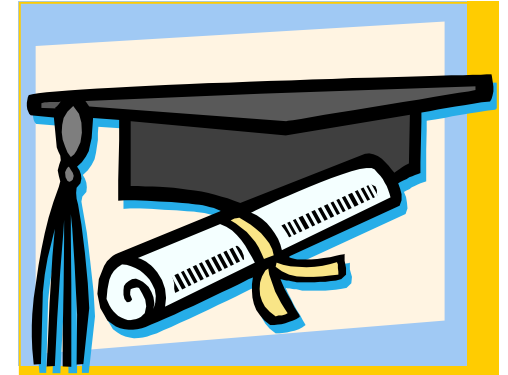

## Board Information

The Education Board is appointed by the City Commission for 1 and 2 year terms with an option to be reappointed for an additional two year consecutive term. The Board includes 11 regular members and two student members.

The Board monitors both public and private schools through their liaison assignment and participation on a School Advisory Council (SAC). The Board is also involved in a wide variety of school and community activities, which promote the quality and special attributes of its schools.
