

Community Management Team

Although the Southwest community and the City of Delray Beach have invested a significant amount of time and resources in the development of the Southwest Area Neighborhood Redevelopment Plan, the process of community improvement has just begun. The key to significant and lasting changes in the community lies in the implementation of the plan.

It is the responsibility of community stakeholders and City Government to ensure that the implementation of this plan is carried out. In order to keep track of the progress for making the future vision for the Southwest area a reality, a Community Management Team (CMT) was established early in the planning process. The CMT includes key community stakeholders who have agreed to work together to ensure that the plan is implemented in accordance with the interests and priorities of the community.

While the CMT has no formal authority, the members have agreed to collaborate and share information on an ongoing basis. The CMT will meet regularly to discuss needs, priorities, implementation, and funding/resource issues.
