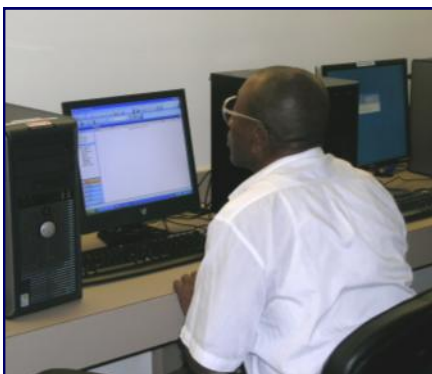

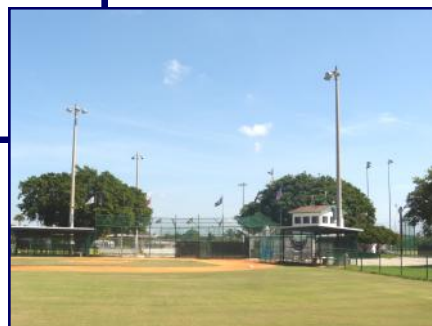

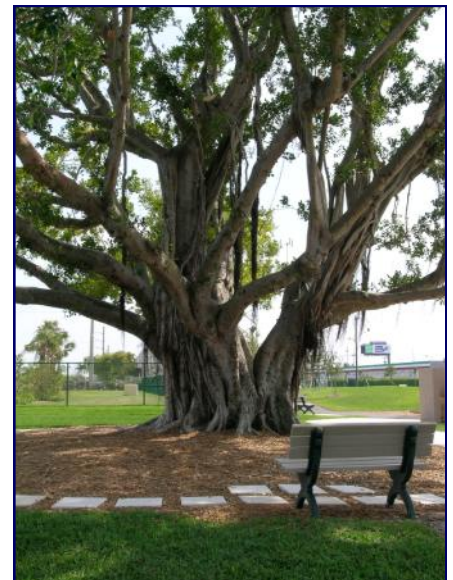

Ocean Rescue Division

The Delray Beach Ocean Rescue Division oversees the safety of 1.5 million beach visitors every year. Delray Ocean Rescue is classified as an “advanced life-saving agency” by the United States Life-saving Association and is 1 of 11 life-saving agencies in Florida to have earned this classification, which indicates the capability to provide a higher level of care.

This Division is composed of 23 part-time and 9 full-time Ocean Rescue Officers. There are also 4 Lieutenants who supervise daily operations, 1 Administrative Assistant and the Superintendent. All Ocean Rescue Officers are licensed EMT's and participate in daily training exercises as a means to ensure the safety of beach visitors.

Delray Beach is proud to have received the “Beach Patrol of the Year” award from the Florida Beach Patrol Chiefs Association more often than any organization in Florida (4 times).

In addition to emergency response services, Ocean Rescue promotes safety through a Junior Lifeguard Program and an educational Ocean Awareness Program that is provided to 4,000 local students annually. Ocean Rescue urges every beach visitor to remember: “ALWAYS SWIM IN FRONT OF A LIFE-GUARD!”

Municipal Beach

Delray Municipal Beach spans one-and-one-half miles of South Florida coastline. Delray Municipal Beach is one of the most accessible (easily accessible from I-95, the beach is centered at the East End of Atlantic Avenue). The City of Delray

Beach contracts with a beach cleaning service and a cabana rental company to insure year round enjoyment of the Municipal Beach for our residents and visitors. Ample metered parking is provided along A-1-A, Sandoway Park, Anchor Park, and Atlantic Dunes Park. Public restrooms are provided at the Sarah Gleason Bathhouse (southwest corner of Atlantic Avenue and A-1-A), the Ocean Rescue Headquarters in Anchor Park, Sandoway Park, and also at Atlantic Dunes Park.

Atlantic Dunes Park

Atlantic Dunes Park is located one block north of Linton Blvd. on A1A. There is a boardwalk and nature trail in addition to metered parking, a pavilion, public restrooms and picnic tables.

Beach Flags

- **Low Hazard:** Conditions are calm; normal care and caution should be exercised.
- **Moderately Hazardous Conditions:** Moderate currents and/or surf are present.
- **Very Hazardous Conditions:** Rough surf and/or strong currents exist; swimmers are strongly discouraged from entering the water.
- ■ **Closed to the Public:** The water and/or beach are closed to the public due to severe currents and/or surf, water pollution, the threat of lightning, or the presence of predatory fish.
- **Marine Pests:** Man o' war, sea-lice, or jelly fish are present. This flag may be flown along with any of the other flags.

Surf Chairs



Two Surf Chairs are available for the physically challenged to enjoy the beach. The chairs allow for mobility on the sand and are available from 9 am until 4:30 pm at the following lifeguard towers: South I, located at AIA & Atlantic Avenue and Atlantic Dunes Park, located on AIA just one block north of Linton Blvd.

The use of the surf chair is free of charge, on a first-come, first-serve basis with a two (2) hour time limit. User must be accompanied by a companion. A driver's license or other form of identification must be provided in exchange for use of the surf chair.

Please Note: To ensure safety, Ocean Rescue Staff are not allowed to assist in the transfer of users from wheelchairs or walkers to the surf chair, nor are they allowed to push the user in the surf chair. Therefore, a companion must accompany the user who is capable of pushing the surf chair.

Sailboat Storage

There is space for sixty non-motorized sailboats to be stored on the north end of the beach. The boats can not exceed twenty feet in length and an annual permit available for everyone is required. Beach Parking Permits

The City of Delray Beach offers a beach parking permit for a total charge of \$84.80 (includes tax) which covers the period from Oct 1 to Sept 30 of each year. Fees are not pro-rated. Beach parking permits are issued according to the City's Code of Ordinances, Section 71.060.

Visit the Utilities Customer Service payment window in the Delray Beach City Hall lobby, 100 NW 1st Ave, Delray Beach to fill out an application, show your proof of vehicle ownership and pay your fee. This \$84.80 fee will authorize the parking of the vehicle for which the permit is acquired in any designated permit only parking space without requiring the payment of money into the space's parking meter. This permit is acceptable within the following city-owned parking lots on AIA: Sandoway Park, Anchor Park, Ingraham Park, Atlantic Dunes, and Marriott/North Lot. 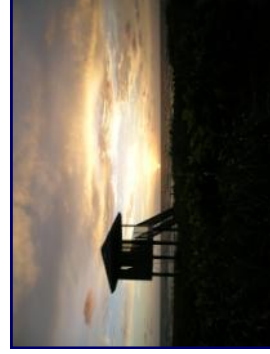
