**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Ms. Annechild, at 5:38 p.m.

**A. Crime Report**

Chief Strianese advised that crime decreased from 16.57% to 10%. He noted that there were a few robberies in the Downtown area and theft to autos throughout the City.

**A. Discuss Goals and Future Direction of The Police Advisory Board**

Ms. Annechild stated that being on the Board has made her a better community member. She spoke of the success of the summer camp program and training programs that she participated in.

Mr. Jackson stated that he has seen a tremendous change in the City of Delray Beach since he took residency in 1984 and has been proud and happy to serve on the Police Advisory Board.

Board members and staff spoke about having quarterly meetings versus monthly meetings.

Ms. Kozol stated that an Ordinance change would be necessary. She also noted that special meetings can be held if necessary.

Mr. Forrest made a motion to change the meeting schedule from monthly to quarterly with the ability to schedule special meetings when necessary. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hartley and passed unanimously.

Mr. Menard spoke of having a Town Hall meeting inviting all the Haitian churches in hopes of alleviating some of the fear that people have about reporting crimes to the police.

Chief Strianese stated that he can assist in coordinating a Town Hall meeting.

Ms. Annechild feels that meeting with the churches is a beneficial method to interact with the community.

Chief Strianese spoke about the pain clinics and different incidents relating to arrests and attempted suicide of people taking pain pills. He noted that he receives daily notifications and that the clinics are being monitored.
