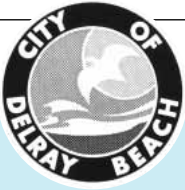

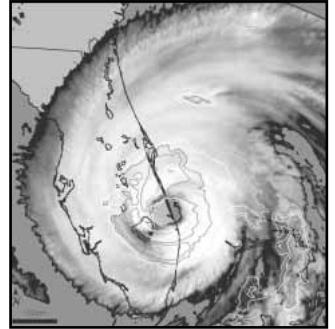

HURRICANE INFORMATION ON DELRAY BEACH CITY WEB-SITE PROVIDES DETAILED UP-DATES

With hurricanes Cindy, Dennis and more recently Emily becoming the earliest and strongest storms threatening our Gulf coasts, the City of Delray Beach web-site (mydelraybeach.com) has up-dates from the Crown Weather Service four times a day (5:00 am, 11:00 am, 5:00 pm, 11:00 pm) which provide the City's Emergency Operations Center with details and images of potentially dangerous storms. This excellent source of heavy weather information is available to all home PC users.

NARRATED BUS TOURS OF HISTORIC DELRAY BEACH POPULAR WITH VISITORS

Visitors and residents alike are taking the Narrated Bust Tour of Historic Delray Beach conducted by the Museum of Lifestyle & Fashion whose director, Lori Durante, acts as tour spokesperson. Comfortable charter busses pick up passengers at the Museum at 11:00 am every fourth Saturday of the month for an excursion through the historic districts of Delray Beach. The Museum of Lifestyle & Fashion is located at 322 NE 2nd Avenue (Pineapple Grove Way), but will be moving to a new location in the near future. For up to date information and to make reservations for the 90 minute tour, call (561) 243-2662. This month's tour is on Saturday, August 27th and excursionists will visit the Colony Hotel, built during Delray's land boom of the 1920's, Sandoway House and Nature Center, built in 1936, the Greater Mt. Olive Baptist Church, established in 1896 and Delray's oldest African American church and St. Paul's Episcopal Church, established in 1904. St. Paul's provided use of its parish hall in the 1970's for Delray's first Jewish synagogue (Temple Sinai) which eventually built their own temple on Atlantic Avenue. Churches were not only centers of faith in Delray Beach. They were the town's social centers, schools and repositories of personal histories and the community's heritage. During the bus tour, the diversity of historic Delray Beach will be highlighted as German, Japanese, Seminole Native Americans, African Americans and Caribbean migrants to South Florida all contributed to the building and development of what was originally Linton then Delray and finally Delray Beach.

DELRAY BEACH BUS SHELTERS ARE ON THE WAY

After months of delays, the shortage of concrete, cancellation of one supplier's contract and finding a new source for bus shelters that meet the City's standards, the new bus shelters are on their way. Concrete pads are under construction and near completion at all 47 bus stop locations.

Brasco International, Inc. is the vendor providing the bus shelter structures and delivery should be made in 10 weeks. All bus shelters (with weather permitting) should be installed sometime before Thanksgiving and could be in place before November.
